CAR BOOT SALES - TERMS AND CONDITIONS for SELLERS and VISITORS

PLEASE ENSURE YOU READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS BEFORE ENTERING THE SITE

- Porthcawl Lions Club, as organisers of the Car Boot Sale will not accept any liability or responsibility for any transactions carried on at the car boot sale or for any loss or damage to any person/s car/property entering the site.
- Person or persons entering this Car Boot Sale do so at their own risk.
- By entering the site Sellers and Visitors are deemed to have read, and agreed to be bound by, the Terms and Conditions - which are set out in full below.
- Sellers must not arrive before 7.15am. Please follow the Marshalls who will give directions to an allocated selling pitch.
- Buying members of the public will be officially admitted after 8.00am. Please follow the Marshalls to the designated car parking area.
- Pitches allocated to sellers are on a first come, first serve basis to a maximum of 100 stalls at the Porthcawl Rugby Club, South Road, Porthcawl. Sellers may have more than one pitch if these are available. Sellers are requested to make a donation of £6.00 per pitch, which will be collected by an identified member of Porthcawl Lions Club.
- Visitors may make a donation of their choice, which will be collected by an identified member of Porthcawl Lions Club.
- As the car boot sale is a fundraising event for Porthcawl Lions Club, refunds will not be given (to sellers and/or visitors) in any circumstances for failure to take up a stall or for earlier leaving.
- By taking a pitch sellers declare and agree that they are attending the event with the purpose of selling their own property.
- Please respect Porthcawl Lions Club members and volunteers. Follow their instructions, especially when it comes to parking and entering/leaving the site. This will assist the safety of our visitors.
- Blue Badge parking is not available but Marshalls will use their best endeavors to find a suitable space but this cannot be guaranteed.
- Porthcawl Lions Club will take all reasonable steps to ensure the event goes ahead as advertised; however in the unlikely event of the event being cancelled owing to circumstances beyond the control of Porthcawl Lions Club, including adverse weather conditions, a notification will be posted to the Club website - www.porthcawllions.org.uk and at the entrance to Car Boot site.
- Sellers may display their items as they wish. Sellers must ensure that any tables, rack, shelves and/or other displays are stable and do not cause an obstruction or hazard to other sellers or visitors.
- Anyone selling the following goods will be asked to leave and will not be refunded for their pitch:
 - Alcohol and stolen goods
 - Any item deemed to be a weapon
 - Counterfeit Goods
 - Pornographic material
 - Any material deemed offensive by identifiable by members of Porthcawl Lions Club
 - Livestock
 - All food lines (with the exception of authorized food traders)
 - Health and safety reasons the following second hand goods are prohibited from sale
 - Cookers and fires (gas/electric)
 - Washing machines and fridges
 - Cosmetics, toiletries
 - All babies and children car seats

Persons found selling prohibited goods will be asked to remove goods from sale Food and Drinks are ONLY to be sold by authorised sellers. In this instance the authorised seller is Porthcawl Rugby Club and their authorised officials, employees and representatives. All electrical appliances offered for sale (other than those prohibited) must be tested and in working order to comply with British Standards. Porthcawl Lions have the right to determine whether an item is suitable for sale. Such decision is final. Porthcawl Lions will not accept any liability or reasonability for any transactions made at the car boot sale .Goods bought in the car boot sale are the sellers and buyers own risk. Sellers are responsible for their own public/product liability insurance. It is the Seller's responsibility to ensure that trading is safe and legal at all times. Children under the age of 14 must not be left to attend a stall on their own. Porthcawl Lions Club does not accept responsibility for lost, damaged or stolen goods or vehicles.

Porthcawl Lions Club (in their absolute discretion) reserve the right to decline entry to anyone, regardless of whether an entry donation has been paid, and without refund or compensation . Pets are permitted on site, but such pets must remain on a lead at all times. Responsibility for all pets allowed on site remains with the person with apparent control. Porthcawl Lions Club reserve the right to ask for any pet to be removed if it is suspected of causing nuisance or annoyance to either Sellers, Buyers or any other visitors to the site.

Sellers and visitors are requested to take their rubbish home, or use rubbish bins around the site. Fly tipping and littering are illegal. Offenders will be reported.
